Members of the Columbus Figure Skating Club along with the Columbus Figure Skating Learn to Skate program and The Ohio State University Learn to Skate Program are all invited to participate in our annual ice show. All levels of skaters are invited to participate in this event. It will feature group numbers for all levels and solos for those CFSC home club members who have passed the intermediate freestyle level.

COST: The cost for participating in the show is \$65 for levels Tots through Basic 8, \$80 for all other levels, and \$50 for participating in a second number. Participation fees pay for costumes, help defray the cost of ice rental, accessories, props, production, and administration costs. Substantial donations have been made to the show by the OSU ice rink, CFSC/OSU professionals and members of the Columbus Figure Skating Club.

Group lesson skaters should enroll at their **current** class level. We reserve the right to combine groups according to enrollment. ** Note- You **MUST** be a current CFSC or OSU Basic Skills student or current CFSC member to be in this show. You can update your basic skills membership on this application. We would love to have you participate so please join us this year!!

REHEARSALS: In order to ensure we have a great show, it is critical that skaters attend all of their scheduled rehearsals. If you need to miss a scheduled practice, please let us know ahead of time so we can be prepared. Off-ice will be scheduled before or after on ice practices as needed per your choreographer. Dress rehearsal and the performance are mandatory, no exceptions!

Dress rehearsal, for all skaters, will be held Friday April 30 from 6:00 - 9:00pm.

PRACTICES: All practices are held at the OSU ice rink. They will be March 27th 6:00-8:15pm, April 3rd 1:30-3:45, April 17th 1:30-3:45 and April 24th 6:00-9:00pm. Your exact practice times and group information will be provided by March 15, 2010 as groups will be determined by show enrollment.

COSTUMES: The costume committee will begin planning the costumes for each group as soon as all applications are received. You will be responsible for costume base, tights and skates. All skaters will wear nude color (light toast) matte tights (No over the boot tights!).

PHOTOS: Photos will be taken of each of the groups during dress rehearsal, and will be available to order throughout the show. A photographer will be available during the rehearsal for individual photos.

T-SHIRTS: The commemorative T-shirt can be ordered on the enclosed application form. Please make sure that you indicate which size you need: Child small, medium, large and Adult small – XXL. The shirts will be available for pickup at the show.

SOLOISTS: Skaters who are Columbus Figure Skating Club home club members and who have passed the USFS Intermediate freestyle test or who are graduating seniors, are eligible to skate a solo in the show. Soloists must also participate in the Soloist group number. Each soloist may choose their own music based upon on the show criteria. The length of music must be no longer than 2:00 minutes. The theme this year is “A Night on the Water” so the music can be anything related to water. Get Creative! **Music choices must be approved by Fiona Loftus, this year’s artistic director, and all music selections must be approved and submitted by March 31st, 2010.** If you need help picking a piece to skate to, Fiona is available to help you with ideas. Soloists will supply their own costumes, which must also be approved by the artistic director.

SEATING: Doors will open at 1:30pm on Saturday. Seating will be first come first served. Donations for the show will be accepted at the door.

VOLUNTEERS: We need your help! Volunteers are a very important part of the show and there are many areas where we need help: Costumes, Ushers, Monitors, Publicity, Set Design/Construction, Set-up/Tear-down, Group Leaders, Flower Table, Photos and Program sales.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: If you have 2 or more skaters in the Show you can take 15% off of your entry fee. This doesn’t include advertising or flowers.

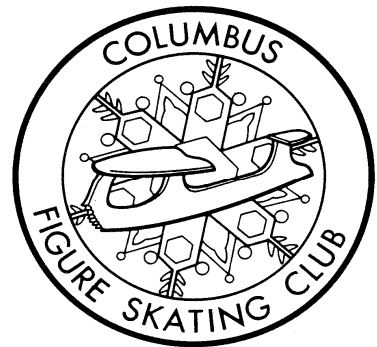
